A. Yes. Sign up for Emerald's "My Profile" and you can set up saved search alerts, table of content alerts, marked lists and much more.

Q. I can get this stuff from Google, can't I?

A. No. Your library purchases access to this database on your behalf, to ensure that you only use the best materials around for your research.

Q. I don't get into the library that much, and want to work from home. Can I access Emerald remotely?

A. Yes you can. Simply talk to your librarian. They will explain how you can access Emerald from off-campus.

Q. Does Emerald support the use of software tools for publishing and managing bibliographies?

A. Yes. The "My Profile" tool allows you to download bibliographic references in ASCII format, ready for exporting into your preferred citation software.
