Admission Requirements:

- 1- Obtaining a high school diploma or equivalent from inside and outside the Kingdom.
- 2- Successfully pass any test or personal interview, including the general aptitude and achievement tests.
- 3- The student must be medically fit.
- 4- Obtaining approval from the reference to study for those who work in any government or private entity.
- 5- He should not have been dismissed from Majmaah University or any other university academically or disciplinarily.

Acceptance Criteria:

(The first criterion: compound ratio) for admission to health and scientific disciplines.

It is calculated as follows:

- 30% of the general abilities score +
- 30% of the cumulative average for the high school degree +
- 40% of the achievement grade

(Second criterion: equivalent percentage) for admission to the humanities and literary majors. It is calculated as follows:

- 50% of the cumulative average for the high school degree +
- 50% of the general abilities score

Stages and procedures of admission:

The admission system aims to facilitate the procedures related to the admission process for male and female students, ensures equal admission opportunities for all applicants, and helps them identify appropriate alternatives among the available programs.

Important note: It should be known that the order of desires is the most important factor for students to obtain the willingness they aspire to through the following:

- 1- Arrange the desires according to the student's preferences and priorities.
- 2- Arranging the desires according to the semester the student wants to join the university. For example, suppose the student desires the Department of Business Administration. In that case, he/she must enter the first term in the first semester and the second desire in the same department in the second semester.
- 3- The Deanship of Admission and Registration will not consider any application unless submitted through the unified electronic admission portal for male



students and the electronic admission portal for female students during the announced application period.

- 4- It is necessary to specify the largest possible number of desires, as increasing the number of desires provides the student with greater chances of acceptance.

Cases of admission cancellation:

Admission is canceled in one of the following cases:

- 1- Incorrect data was entered in the online admission application.
- 2- A previous record of the student exists in the student records system at the university.
- 3- The student is being dismissed academically.
- 4- Not clicking on the OK box (confirm acceptance) during the nomination period.

1- Diploma in Programming and Computer Science:

General Objective:

This program qualifies students to acquire the necessary skills to use programming languages for computer development. During his studies, the student is trained to apply strategies related to developing applications professionally and gains the ability to manage software projects related to databases. The student also acquires the necessary competence to deal with networks and databases, manage them, and create applications



for the desktop or web. Notably, student qualification in software is an essential part of the digital transformation movement stipulated in the Kingdom's Vision 2030, which aims to develop the digital infrastructure and support local investments in the communications and information technology sector.

Job Opportunities for Graduates:

The graduate student can work in various fields of the public and private sectors related to programming database applications, especially with the introduction of fifth-generation technology and the increased demand for the design and development of computer applications and web services related to them directly or indirectly, such as:

- Desktop applications and database developer, whether working in public or private sector institutions or by starting a personal business as a startup company.
- Managing software projects so that institutions and companies require the presence of a manager for the databases provided by users of those institutions by interacting with them.
- Web services developer by building services that interact with databases to provide information in computer and web applications.

Frequently Asked Questions:

1. Is priority in admission for those who have obtained this year's high school diploma?
Priority in admission to those who obtain the highest grades according to the announced admission criteria.
2. Is there an application for admission in the second semester?
The admission gate opens once a year, and students of the first and second semesters are accepted.
3. Is the application paper or electronic?
The application is fully electronic, and there is no need to receive any certificates or documents from the student, except for special cases, they are contacted to bring the original documents, for example, a non-Saudi student from a Saudi mother who holds an international secondary certificate or outside the Kingdom.
4. Are holders of a high school diploma from outside the Kingdom required to take the National Measurement Center tests?



All applicants for admission to the university and holders of a high school diploma from outside the Kingdom are required to take the general aptitude test and achievement.

5. Can non-Saudis residing in the Kingdom apply for admission to the university? Distinguished students residing in the Kingdom can be accepted following the regulations governing this in Saudi universities through the scholarship portal for non-Saudis.
