muscarinic antagonist

- ▣ Uses of atropine/ muscarinic
antagonist
- ▣ Organophosphorous poisoning
- ▣ Fundoscopic examination of
eye- Mydriasis
- ▣ Pre-anaesthetic medication
- ▣ Parkinsons disease
- ▣ Asthma/ COPD
- ▣ Urinary urgency
- ▣ Motion sickness
- ▣ Bradycardia
- ▣ Peptic ulcer disease / IBD

- ▣ Adverse effects of atropine / Muscarinic antagonist
- ▣ Constipation
- ▣ Dryness of mouth
- ▣ Blurring of vision
- ▣ Drowsiness
- ▣ Tachycardia / palpitation
- ▣ Photophobia / decreased accommodation

Note: Atropine toxicity is treated with physostigmine
