





• The nature of the scientific content that is taught in this course which is characterized by difficulty compared to other courses in the study plan for the program.

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- Factors associated with non-adherence the students in registration conditions and she may do not take into account the priority of some courses that are pre-requisted to organic chemistry course
- general levels of students accepted in the program are often in between the medium and the weak couse of the relatively low rate required for admission the students In pre-university educational stage in Biology program
- The phenomenon of absenteeism of some students and increase the proportion of non-attendance pevents enough understanding of some scientific topics in this course which reflected on the weak performance of the students and made the results in low level




